Stories come alive on stage as theatre troupe plays back stories from the audience, generating community dialogue that is both deeply personal and powerfully universal.

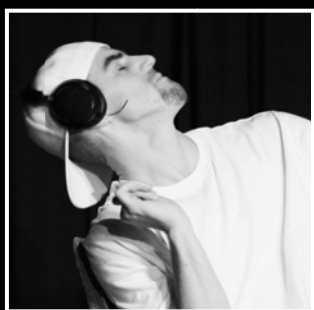


## ***Koko Jones***
